ICE BREAKER QUESTION:

How would you describe your decision making process when faced with important life choices?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) Which of Daniel's character traits, as seen in these passages, do you think helped him the most while in exile in Babylon?

HEART

These questions will be geared towards shaping our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with that which we believe in our hearts.

- 3) What do we learn about God through Daniel's story? How was Daniel's relationship with God deepened while in exile?
- 4) How have you seen God's provision when you have taken new steps of faith to follow Him? How does sharing your testimony and hearing others' stories strengthen your resolve to follow Him even further?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change the way that we live.
