Discussion Questions

Note: This quarter we will be featuring three categories of questions - Head, Heart and Hands. As followers of Jesus we want our entire lives to be transformed by His Spirit: our head (what we think), our hearts (what we trust and put our hope in), and our hands (our deeds and actions).

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in these verses or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) "...as God's chosen ones, holy and beloved" (v.12). How does your understanding of your identity in Christ affect your view of yourself? How is that important as we live out our faith in community with others?

HEART

These questions will be geared towards shaping our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

3) What are some of the ways that God transforms us in community? How has God used relationships with other members of your church family or the body of Christ to grow you?





4) As you understand being adopted by God (Eph. 1:5), how does that help shape your heart towards those in your church family that you don't connect with easily or don't understand?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change the way that we live.

5) In light of this passage, is there a specific exhortation you want to grow in (i.e. kindness, the peace of Christ, love, etc)? How can you support your other Life Group members and others in our church family in their growth?
