ICEBREAKER QUESTION: What are you most grateful for this holiday season?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) What truths do we learn about life and death in this passage?

HEART

These questions will shape our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) When we are crucified with Christ, what role does the Holy Spirit have in our lives?
- 4) What specific story or example from your life can you share about the Holy Spirit making a move in your life?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

5) How can you tell when you are not living by faith in the Son of God? How do you get back on track?
