ICEBREAKER QUESTION: What is your strongest sense?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) In what ways does Paul correct the Galatians to exalt the role of the Holy Spirit as higher than that of our works?

Going Deeper: Which of Paul's questions in verses 1-5 resonates with you the most and why?

HEART

These questions will shape our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) Is there anything in your life that can distract you from or blur your vision of the person and work of Christ?
- 4) How do you discern skewed theology in yourself or a friend? What does the gift of discernment add to your relationship with God and others?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

5) Is there anyone (inside or outside of your Life Group) that the Holy Spirit has put on your mind with which to further discuss or pray over any of these truths from Galatians 3?
