ICEBREAKER QUESTION: What is a silly joke you know or have heard recently?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) In what ways does Micah propose the gospel goes beyond personal salvation?

HEART

These questions will shape our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) How does contentment and generosity in the Lord permit us to elevate others around us? How does this principle relate to the gospel?
- 4) What are the consequences of believing in only part of God's Word or nature?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

- 5) What do you need to confess in order to be reorganized under the leadership of our Shepherd King?
