ICEBREAKER QUESTION:

Who is your favorite Bible character, and what do you love about their story?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) What do we learn about Jesus and the gospel from Paul's testimony to the Galatians?

HEART

These questions will be geared towards shaping our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) How could someone else learn about Jesus when hearing your story (testimony)?

Going Deeper: Have you ever shared your testimony before? If so, share with the group about your conversion experience. If not, pray that God will give you the opportunity to do so this week.

- 4) How does the gospel change us as believers, and what can it produce in us?

Going Deeper: What do you see God producing in one another within your Life Group? Share this encouragement with one another as we follow Christ together!

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

- 5) Who can you share your testimony with this week?

Prayer Application: Pray for God to provide opportunities for you and your group members to share your testimony with those around you this week.
