ICEBREAKER QUESTION: What is something about your personality that it may take someone a long time to learn?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) In this passage, what promises does God make to Israel through the prophet Micah? What do these promises reveal about God's relationship with his people?

HEART

These questions will shape our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) In what ways does the promise of restoration by the Shepherd-King speak to your current spiritual or emotional challenges?
- 4) Can you describe a personal experience in which you felt God working to transform your life or perspective?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

5) What confession do you need to make today that would turn you toward God's restorative, peaceful, and transformative work in your life?
