### **ICEBREAKER QUESTION:**

What is the most beautiful thing you have seen this week?

### HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) In this passage, what stands out to you about how Paul maintains the integrity and beauty of the gospel?

### **HEART**

These questions will be geared towards shaping our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) Is it easy or hard for you when you try to receive the gospel, rather than "earn" it? Why?
- 4) How does Christ's Lordship grant believers freedom from certain things and freedom for others?

Going Deeper: How can you more fully embrace God's freedom that the gospel provides?

### **HANDS**

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

5) Through you, how can the versatility of the gospel bless the people in your life and community this week?

**Prayer Application**: Pray for the church, as individuals and a collective body, to further understand their responsibility through the gospel to those who need to experience the good news.
