Exodus 7-10 (Exodus 7:13-25, 10:21-29) Pastor Nate Holdridge

ICEBREAKER QUESTION: What is a memorable costume you have worn yourself or seen someone else wear in public?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) What were some of the key Egyptian gods or beliefs that each plague directly confronted?

HEART

These questions will shape our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

3) Why did God want the Israelites to remember and retell the stories of the plagues to future generations? What is a testimony that you believe God wants you to retell?

Going Deeper: Who can you tell this testimony to this week?

4) When have you witnessed God fighting on your behalf in a difficult season of life? How did that make you feel about Him or deepen your understanding of His character?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

5) How can remembering God's past faithfulness increase your trust in His sovereignty in your current circumstances?

Prayer Application: Pray for the Good News Club, a ministry of Child Evangelism Fellowship. Pray that the Bible stories told by trained volunteers to groups of children in local schools would be heard and well-received!
