ICEBREAKER QUESTION: What one or two words would you use to describe the last 24 hours of your life?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) Why did God require the blood of the lamb to be put on the doorposts for the Israelites to be passed over? What did this foreshadow?

HEART

These questions will shape our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) How does this passage help you appreciate both God's justice and His patience?

Going Deeper: What emotions does considering God's justice and patience stir in you?

- 4) What false narratives can we be tempted to live from instead of the truth that we are a delivered people?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

- 5) Is there any mindset or habit you need to adjust in light of the Passover story and its fulfillment in Christ? What practical step can you take this week?
