ICE BREAKER QUESTION:

When was the last time you embarked on a brand new adventure on your own? Describe your situation and your reflections as you began the journey.

HEAD

- 4) What role does the Holy Spirit play in the proclamation of the gospel? How can you use the gifts that the Holy Spirit has given to you to talk about Jesus with others?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change the way that we live.

- 5) After studying this passage, what is one thing that you are going to do to share the gospel this week?
- 6) At the conclusion of our study of Mark, what is the one theme, truth or story that has impacted you most significantly? How have you seen opportunities in your life to follow our Servant-Savior, Jesus?
