## **ICE BREAKER QUESTION:**

Have you ever felt like an outsider? Describe what that was like for you.

## **HEAD**

*These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).*

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) In Peter's letter he refers to the believers as *exiles*. What makes someone an exile? In what ways are we, as followers of Christ living as exiles today in our society?

## **HEART**

*These questions will be geared towards shaping our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.*

- 3) Peter encouraged his readers in their primary identity as the chosen and elect children of God. How does this truth comfort you today? In what ways does your kingdom identity give you courage and hope to live as an exile in our world?
- 4) In verse 2, Peter references the work of the trinity in calling us and commissioning us for His mission in the world. How do these truths speak to you? What is one area that you sense God is calling you to grow in as you seek to join in His mission to the lost world (i.e. how you speak, where you place your hope, how you spend your time, etc.)?

## **HANDS**

*This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change the way that we live.*

- 5) After studying this passage, what is one thing that you are going to do to apply this to your life?
