## ICE BREAKER QUESTION:

Have you ever rejected something or someone in your life (a theology, practice or relationship, for example)? Describe the situation and your response.

## HEAD

## HEART

*These questions will be geared towards shaping our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.*

- 3) How does God's relentless pursuit of Peter's redemption influence your heart toward Christ? In what ways can you relate to Peter?
- 4) How does God use our prayers to open our eyes and see the sin that separates us from Him? What personal unrighteousness or public injustice do you sense the Lord needs to open your eyes to see? Are there others that can join you in prayer for this?

## HANDS

*This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change the way that we live.*
