ICE BREAKER QUESTION:

What is your favorite book or movie? What is it about the narrative arc or story that you cherish the most?

HEAD

- 4) What did you learn about baptism this week? What aspect(s) of the symbolism of water baptism do you relate to the most? (verse 21-21)

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change the way that we live.

5) How does the truth of Christ's death and resurrection comfort us in considering our present and our future circumstances? What steps can you take to receive more of God's truth every day?
