ICE BREAKER QUESTION:

What is your most valued possession and why do you cherish it?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in these verses or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) How does Jesus help the rich young man and the disciples understand the cost of prioritizing their relationship with God?

HEART

These questions will be geared towards shaping our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) What does Jesus' teaching about wealth reveal to us about hindrances we may allow to prevent us from following Him most fully? Can you identify specific hindrances currently standing in the way of you putting Jesus first in your life?
- 4) Jesus tells the disciples that the pursuit of God's kingdom comes with reward. What elements of this reward, mentioned in the passage, resonate most with you? How can this promise give you hope in times of struggle?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change the way that we live.

- 5) What is one thing that you are going to do after studying this passage? Is there a promise to claim, a pattern of thinking to change, or a situation to entrust into



God's care? Invite the work of the Holy Spirit into your life this week as you yield to Him.
