ICE BREAKER QUESTION:

What's your favorite fruit?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) How is the fig tree a picture of what was happening in Israel? What was the true purpose of the temple and how were the High Priests corrupting it thus turning it into a "den of robbers"?

HEART

These questions will be geared towards shaping our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) Pastor Nate reminded us that we are the temple of God and He dwells inside us collectively and individually. How does this truth minister to you? What are some ways you can apply this truth in your life today?
- 4) Jesus tells His disciples in verse 22 to "have faith in God". In what new ways are you having to put your faith in God during this unprecedented year? How has God shown Himself faithful through this season?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change the way that we live.

5) What good fruit would you like God to produce in your life (be specific)? What can you do to cultivate a heart (root) that is healthy in order that God may produce good fruit in your life.
