## ICE BREAKER QUESTION:

## HEAD

## HEART

- 3) What outside voices compete with Jesus' Word in your life?
- 4) What can you do during this season to cultivate a heart (soil) that is ready to receive the Word in order that you might bear much fruit?

## HANDS

*This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change the way that we live.*

- 5) How does this parable encourage you to live differently this week? What will you do to apply the truth of this passage to your life?
