ICEBREAKER QUESTION: What attribute of God has been most visible to you this week? How so?

HEAD

These questions will help us understand what the scripture teaches (who God is, what He's done, who we are, and how we should live).

- 1) What stood out to you in this section of scripture or from Sunday's sermon?
- 2) What does the name "Micah" mean, and how does this meaning enhance the message of Micah 7?

HEART

These questions will shape our hearts in light of the gospel. Our goal will be to align what we know with what we believe in our hearts.

- 3) What verses in Micah 7 or other biblical truths can help us trust that God's future plans for our salvation will unfold?
- 4) How does our knowledge of God bring transformation in our lives as believers?

HANDS

This question will be geared towards us responding to the passage by allowing the Holy Spirit to change how we live.

- 5) Considering Micah's emphasis on God's justice and mercy, how should this influence our behavior towards others, especially those who are marginalized?

Prayer Application: Pray for the people in our church to grasp God's vision of how we should seek justice, love mercy, and walk humbly with Him.
